What the Research Shows

A study* of 235 IDT graduates showed that Advanced Course graduates were far more likely to be highly confident in using IDT (p.18). "IDT [was] seen to be useful for a wide range of presenting issues ... **particularly when practitioners are sufficiently skilled in its use**, and able to deal with client resistances. Both of **these factors highlight that intending practitioners should undertake more advanced training**, as currently provided" (p.29).

The New 2010 Course Structure
